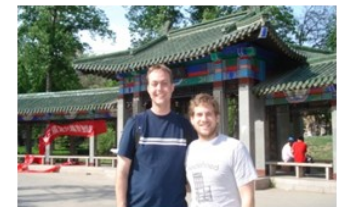
3. Send
